## BOZENKILL PARK FEES:

### Swimming:

\*\$2 per person (5 and under free)

\*Free senior swim pass (62+)

\*\$40 individual seasonal swim pass

\*\$100 family of four seasonal swim pass (\$20 additional family member)

### Swim Lessons:

\*\$25 for five lessons (flexible schedule)

\*Starting July 5

\*3-12 year olds

\*Register with the Village Office (forms available online)



### PARKING:

\*Village of Altamont residents-FREE Stickers available at Village Office or from Booth Attendant

\*\$10 non-resident parking per visit

\*\$50 Non-resident seasonal parking pass available at Village Office or from Booth Attendant

**BOZENKILL PARK GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- “Carry In-Carry Out” policy
- Park only in designated areas
- Metal detectors prohibited
- Open fires in designated areas only
- No cutting, carving, or defacing of trees, shrubs, etc.
- No destruction or defacing of Village building or property
- No off road motorized vehicles allowed
- No overnight parking allowed
- All use of Village grounds, fields, courts and specified areas are at one’s own risk.
- The Village is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
- Restrooms are available in recreation pavilion
- No bare feet except in pool area
- Negative behavior jeopardizes use of the park
- All children 14 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult 18 and older
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- Skateboards and roller blades/inline skates are prohibited



**POOL RULES:**

- \*Pool open only when lifeguard is on duty
- \*No diving, jumping, pushing, running, or rough play in pool area
- \*No food or drink allowed in pool area
- \*No glass on the pool deck
- \*Please use bathrooms provided
- \*Proper pool attire required
- \*Floats must be Coast Guard approved

**FIELD & COURT RULES:**

- \*First come first use basis
- \*Organized teams must submit a Request for Use of Park Facilities form & Certificate of Insurance (available online or at Village Offices)
- \*No climbing or sitting on fences or backstops
- \*Proper footwear required on tennis courts
